The NCRA [National Cancer Registrars Association] website is the accrediting agency and resource for everything you need to know.

On the NCRA website [www.ncra-usa.org] go under 'CTR', then 'Potential CTRs' you arrive at a page with links for Eligibility, CTR Exam Prep and Accredited Education Programs.

Includes various resources for CTR exam prep – webinars, study guide, online cancer case studies.

Many of the programs are online. When researching, pay attention to the practicum portion – specifically does the program assist you with finding a facility to complete the practicum, or is it your responsibility to find one. This can be a challenging area for many students.

Additionally, consider joining the NCRA Facebook page – National Cancer Registrars Association. The page can be searched for posts on specific programs, review prior discussion, or post a question specifically asking about a program you're considering.
